## Who We Are

#### The Cause

Today, amidst trying times and new challenges, the need for authentic scholars possessing sound, comprehensive knowledge of Islam, as well as profound understanding of modern Muslim societies is apparent. It is high time that we formally train and nurture talented individuals from our communities to stand up to the challenges and needs of Muslims in North America by playing the crucial roles of guides, mentors and educators.

#### What is this Degree?

The <u>Bachelors in Islamic Sciences</u> is commonly known as the 'Alim course'. It is a course that has been implemented worldwide and proves to be immensely beneficial in preserving and spreading the sacred sciences of Islam. It is designed to successfully educate and empower students to reach a high academic understanding of Arabic, Jurisprudence, Hadith, Creed, recitation of the Qur'an and exegesis as well as maintaining close connections with authorized Islamic scholars.

## Our Flagship Endeavor: The Islamic Scholarship ('Alimiyyah) Program

#### What is achieved by the Bachelors?

The <u>License in Islamic Scholarship</u> is the most distinguished degree awarded and can be likened to post-graduate degrees awarded in the Canadian education system. After successfully completing the final exams, students will graduate from the Institute as an <u>'Alim or 'Alimah</u> in full, with a portfolio of asanid (chains of transmission) and *ijazat* collected over the years studying with the institute and meeting scholars. Thereby obtaining the *Shahadah Aalamiyyah* (proof of Islamic scholarship).

#### Is this an Accredited Program?

The Shahadah Alamiyyah is a program implemented globally. Graduates from this program will be eligible to continue their Islamic studies in one of many Islamic institutes and universities throughout the world. Graduates will also receive transcripts and testimony on behalf of the institute to aid in their future pursuits for knowledge.

## Requirements for enrollment

- Desire to learn the sacred sciences of Islam
- Basic ability to read the Arabic language
- Strong work ethic
- Punctuality and Seriousness

## Program Structure

'Alimiyyah program consists of 3 levels, which can be completed in a period of 6 years.

**Level 1** focuses on granting the foundational language tools for success in future studies while covering the fundamental aspects of Figh and Beliefs.

**Level 2** builds on the theological foundations established in Level 1 and introduces students to the sciences of Quranic Exegesis and Prophetic Discourse (Hadith).

**Level 3** delves further into the study of Prophetic Discourses whilst providing a greater understanding of everyday applications.

Completion of each level will be achieved after 2 years of study.



## Year 1

The first year is preparatory with an emphasis on the basics of Arabic grammar, speech, and reading as well as tajwid and the basics of Islamic beliefs and practices. The first level is taught in English, with the course material gradually shifting to Arabic from the second level onwards.

#### Students will practice

Syntax and grammar of the Arabic language, language exercises, vocabulary. Beginner Arabic conversation skills, practice in implementing learnt rules. Basic Islamic rulings and jurisprudence such as purity, prayers, alms, fasting, pilgrimage, and answers to common issues. Correcting pronunciation of the Arabic letters, leading into the correct recitation of the Noble Qur'an.

## Year 2

The second year involves delving deeper into subjects pertaining to traditional Arabic language arts with the aim of developing mastery in reading, writing, composition and speaking pure Arabic, as well in the various aspects of Arabic grammar such as syntax, etymology, conjugation, and inflection.

#### Students will practice

Arabic literature, reading Arabic texts and learning the art of translating from Arabic to English, intermediate Arabic conversation skills. Practice conjugating verbs, essential principles for verbal sentences. Studying Prophetic traditions, covering a wide range of topics including beliefs, worships, and more. Studying the analytic breakdown (tarkib) of the nominal and verbal sentences and the reality behind the many misconceptions which exist about Islam.

## Year 3

The third year includes an introduction to the art of translating the Quran as well as various texts of figh and uşul of figh.

#### **Students will practice**

Intermediate Islamic rulings and jurisprudence studied through classical Arabic texts. Intermediate Arabic literature. A study of Prophetic traditions, covering a wide range of topics including beliefs, worships, and more. Learning the principles of jurisprudence, and understanding the methodology of the jurists. Learning about the life and the challenges of Prophet Muhammad ...

## Year 4

The fourth year includes a continuation of Qur'an translation. The uşul governing Tafsir as well as figh are studied in great depth. Concepts in 'Aqidah are also taught.

#### Students will practice

Advanced Islamic rulings and jurisprudence studied through classical Arabic texts.

Advanced Arabic literature, reading Arabic texts and learning the art of translating from Arabic to English. Learning the principles of jurisprudence, and understanding the methodology of the jurists. Studying the fundamental beliefs of Islam, an in depth look into the Islamic creed.



## Year 5

The fifth year deals with the higher texts of Hadith, Fiqh and Tafseer. The famous hadith compilation of Khatib al-Tabrizi, Mishkāt al-maşabīḥ along with Tahawī is studied in great depth, along with essential usul al-ḥadīth works such as the Mukhtaşar of Sharif al-Jurjānī and Sharh Nukhbat al-fikar of Ibn Hajar. In tafsir, the renown Jalalayn, as well as the Tafsirs of Ibn Kathir and Baydawī are taught.

#### Students will practice

Comparative methodologies. Deep study of the principles and necessary knowledge required to study exegesis of the Noble Qur'an. Quranic Exegesis Studying the meaning and interpretation of the Noble Qur'an. Study of advanced text regarding the principles and rulings of Hadith and their applications. Advance study of different of schools of thought in Islam.

## Year 6

The sixth year deals exclusively with the major hadith works. The iconic compilations of Imams al-Bukhārī, Muslim, at-Tirmidhi, Abu Dawud, an-Nasā'ī, Ibn Majah and the Muwatta' of Imam Malik and Imam Muhammad ibn al-Hasan are studied.

#### Students will practice

Advanced analysis of the chains (asnād), historical background, and context of each narration, as well as the related and extrapolated aḥkām of Bukhārī, Muslim, Tirmidhi, Abū Dawud, Nasā'ī, Muwatta' Imam Malik, Muwatta' Imam Muhammad, and Ibn Majah.



## Program Details

Our part-time 'Alimiyyah course offers a rich and immersive learning experience for all Muslim brothers and sisters. The program is intended for individuals who wish to become more engaged in Islamic learning at a higher level than would otherwise be available.
